
## Walkabout Exercise

<p><b>Common arrival and dismissal times from the venue</b></p>	
<p><b>Location of venue entrances</b></p>	
<p><b>Staff parking/available visitor parking:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>oPotential for vehicle and pedestrian conflict</li> <li>oSize and design of parking lot. Is traffic flow clearly signed?</li> <li>oPavement markings on the parking lot</li> <li>oParking and driving behaviours</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Walking paths to the venue:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>oWhere are the access points for staff/visitors?</li> <li>oPotential for conflict with vehicles</li> <li>oLighting along walkways</li> <li>oMaintenance of walkways, i.e. snow and ice removed; mud, puddles need filling</li> <li>oAlternate access routes, i.e. from back fields, from adjacent park</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Bicycle facilities:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>oBike racks: are they secure? sheltered?</li> <li>oBike paths or lanes</li> <li>oBest cycle routes identified?</li> <li>oPotential for conflict with vehicles</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Universal Access:</b></p> <p>Ramps, any special entrances or accommodations for differently-abled visitors</p>

Area Surrounding Venue Site

Things to consider on your walk:	Notes:
Volume and speed of traffic on surrounding streets: perceived and real	
Are there sidewalks? How far do they extend around the venue and into the surrounding community?	
Are pedestrian crossing devices present and utilized?	
Sight distances. Look at crosswalks, road curves, blind corners, or transit bus zones - where might sight become an issue?	
Placement of crosswalks in relation to driveways and loading zones	
Timing of traffic lights	
On-street signs
